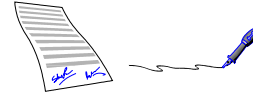

Background/Introduction

One of the outcomes of the Strategy Planning Conference held in Las Vegas was for An Taclobanon to conduct various fund-raising activities, to support the Medical Mission Project in Leyte. Among other projects, a golf tournament was planned and conducted to support the associations projects and programs.

Executive Summary

Forty golfers teed off on a bright, sunny morning for the An Taclobanon Golf Challenge Tournament. The fun event raised a gross amount of \$5,866—exceeding all expectations. Net proceeds are earmarked for the Medical Mission Project in Leyte in February of 2006. In addition to the participation of golfers, many individuals contributed their time, talents, treasures and efforts toward making the event a success.

“We are very pleased with the turn-out for this event, we hope to do this again next year, and we thank everybody for their generous support” said Patrick David, this year’s Chairman for the Tournament.

Eric Cordeta, Tournament Vice-Chairman said *“As amateurs holding this type of event, this was very successful, and with the experience gained, there’s lots of room for improvement when the next tournament is held. The real winners are the recipients of the project who will benefit from everybody’s contributions.”*

With a goal of raising at least \$5,000 for the Leyte Medical Mission Project, the Inaugural Golf Challenge tournament was held on Sunday, May 15, 2005 at the Mountain Meadows Golf Course in Pomona.

Highlights and quick summary:

- A total of 40 players registered and participated
- A registration fee of \$85.00 was charged each participant.
- A fee of \$55.00 per player was paid to the Mountain Meadows Golf course.
- 15 tee sponsors donated a total amount of \$2,175.00
- One of the sponsors, Marjhorie Florendo D’Angelo of Realty Executives was the biggest donor at \$500.
- Trophies were awarded to the Champions, the 1st Runners-up and 2nd Runners-up (see photos)
- Special awards were given to Zeb de los Santos for the Longest Drive as well as to Mike Cordeta for Closest to the pin.
- Immediately following the conclusion of the tournament, The awards ceremonies and socials were held outdoors at the lovely residence of Susan and Lito David.
- Catering services was provided by Jeannette Bailey, Mariza Cordeta, and Annie Lagado all from the group known as “Flowers and Edibles.”
- Other donations in kind came from various individuals; these included services, drinks, bags of ice, etc.
- Feedback from participants were positive. Among the several recommendations, many of the golfers strongly suggested holding another tournament sooner than later.
- A committee will look into making improvements for the next tournament; recommendations will be presented at the appropriate time.

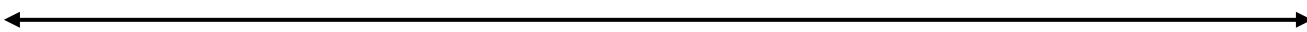

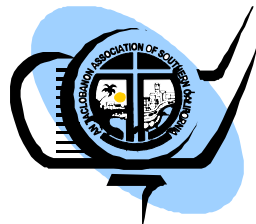
